#### **Bike Walk Wichita: Tours & Routes app**

The app is almost ready! Dom & Roz are close to having it ready to upload walking and biking routes. We will have a route training on June 28th at 5:30pm, everyone interested is invited. You can download the app in Google Play Store or the ITunes Store. The app will have "self-guided" tours with photos & info that will "pop-up" as you walk/bike along (or you can manually move along the route by swiping, instead of using your phone GPS). ### **Northeast Wichita Updates**

It has already been one year and our grant is wrapping up. Fortunately, the grant just helped boost our efforts; we will continue engaging and supporting efforts in Northeast Wichita! Couple of updates:

- Place Making Project will be installed in July. We are partnering with the city to permanently install the seating and table to create a small gathering area at Douglas & the Canal Route. Kim will keep us posted. The grant will pay for the cement pad and we will install the donated bike air pump.
- **HealthCore Clinic** is almost done with their walking path. They will let us know when they are ready to promote it. We provided a \$500 mini-grant to help with the installation of a bike rack.
- **Iasis Christian Center** will be conducting walkability audits in NE Wichita. This will help test our Walkability Audit tool.

- **Second Sunday Slow Roll** will kick-off on July 8th. Join us at Exploration Place at 4pm for a leisurely ride along the river. This is perfect for beginners and children. We will host this monthly.
- Santa Fe Lake Bike Camping Trip July 28-29. Several have expressed interest in this self-supported ride & overnight campout, but ride leaders are needed! Please let Jack know if you are interested in helping out.

### **BWW WorkGroup Updates**

**WomenBikeICT** – SHE Bikes Summit + Ride was a success! 55 women attended, most we did not know. The women will be scheduling a meeting and rides soon. Moriah & Aimee are planning rides.

**Education** – Continues to schedule a variety of bike education classes, check out the calendar for a full list of classes. *Next meeting is Tuesday, July 10<sup>th</sup> at 5:30pm* (bike ride to Aero Plains Brewery for mtg)

**ReCycle** – Continues receiving and repairing bikes for those in need of transportation. Hours have been expanded on Saturdays to 10am-4pm. Bike repair days are *every Tues & Thurs 6-8pm & Sat 1-4pm* at BWW HQ's. Drop in, everyone and all skill levels welcome! We have a good supply of kid bikes that need fixing up. Jack and Carey will host a table for World Refugee Day. We are expanding into the new space and building new workbenches.

**Pedestrian** – Walkability Audits are coming in! We are promoting them on Facebook and receiving a lot of attention. Jack has set up our ESRI account, so we now have access to the data. Barbara is scheduling the

Riverside Park Walkabout for 9-11am on July 21st in celebration of Wichita's birthday. *Next meeting is Tuesday, July 3rd at 4:30pm.* 

Outreach/Communications – We will start our Second Sunday Slow Roll rides in July. This is a no drop. We also need volunteers to help with several upcoming events. Clayton Pearson is working on mapping bike parking throughout the city, including what type of facility. He has created a Google Map that will be shared soon. He will be looking for help plotting the locations.

Sharon mentioned that we need to push the city to proceed with developing the low water bridge that will help connect the Prairie Sunset Trail to Wichita.
